Central Valley



Chile is blessed with a fortunate combination of geographical and climatic characteristics. Impressive natural barriers have protected this beautiful land creating the perfect conditions for vine growing.

It was the strong passion for good wine that moved the owners to create the Terra Noble estate in 1993. The vineyards are located in Colchagua and Maule Valley. The first area lies in the heart of Central Valley, 140 Km south of Santiago. It receives the direct influence of the ocean that imparts a Mediterranean-like weather to the whole region. Maule Valley is down to the south run through by the Maule river. The valley, that counts about 30% of all Chilean vineyards, has a cooler climate.

The philosophy of the winery is to produce elegant “noble” wines that at the same time are refreshing, fruit driven. To reach this goal only the best healthier grapes are selected. The yield of the vineyards is kept low to ensure maximum concentration of aromas and flavors.





Carmenerre, Maule Valley 2004

Vine variety: 85% Carmenerre, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon

Aging: Refining in stainless steel tanks

Alcohol: 14% vol.

Medium age of vineyard: 13 years

Tasting notes: Dark ruby red. The nose is rich with berries and chocolate notes. A solid structure supported by good tannins, well balanced with a touch of spiciness.



Carmenerre reserva, Maule Valley 2003

Vine variety: 85% Carmenerre, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon

Aging: 60% of the wine 5 months in French barrique, the remaining 40% refined in stainless steel tanks

Alcohol: 13.5% vol.

Medium age of vineyard: 13 years

Tasting notes: Very intense dark red color. Intriguing nose with aromas of figs, berries and chocolate. Full body with silky tannins and a hint of coffee. Very long lingering finish



Merlot, Maule Valley 2003

Vine variety: 100% Merlot

Aging: Refining in stainless steel tanks

Alcohol: 13.5% vol.

Medium age of vineyard: 13 years

Tasting notes: Intense ruby red with brick-red rim. Intense nose with aromas of cherry, strawberry, plums and a light note of eucalyptus. Round and silky.



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Merlot Reserva, Maule Valley, 2003

Vine variety: 100% Merlot

Aging: 60 % of the wine 5 months in french barrique, the remaining 40% refined in stainless steel tanks

Alcohol: 13.5% vol.

Medium age of vineyard: 13 years

Tasting notes: Ruby red with an intriguing nose rich of herbs and spices. A silky very well balanced structure with plenty of cherry, raspberry and cloves notes. A light sweet wood note on the palate with a hint of tobacco. A very elegant wine.

**Syrah, Maule Valley 2004****Vine variety:** 100% Syrah**Aging:** Refining in stainless steel tanks**Alcohol:** 13.5% vol.**Medium age of vineyard:** 13 years

Tasting notes: Deep ruby red with a violet rim. The nose has a very distinct black pepper notes. Very concentrated with a lots of red fruits, cassis and olives. Well balanced with round tannins and and harmonic structure.



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
